#### AMENDMENT OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 147 OF 30 AUGUST 2002: AGRONOMIC INDUSTRY ACT, 1992

Under section 18(3) of the Agronomic Industry Act, 1992 (Act No. 20 of 1992), I amend the Schedule to Government Notice No. 147 of 2002 by the substitution for paragraph 3 of the following paragraph, with effect from 01 May 2012:

- “3. Any person who purchases controlled products from a person referred to in paragraph 1 or 2, as the case may be, shall pay a general levy of one comma four percent (1.4%) on the selling price concerned or the landed cost concerned, as the case may be, of the controlled product so purchased.”.

From there boundary moves in southerly direction to reach point 6. Narawandu Gate coordinates S -18° 39 18.1 and E 015° 32 48.6 where it continues going east in a straight line to reach point 7. Oshiwalandu coordinates S -18° 40 52.6 and E 015° 37 49.6. Boundary moves northern direction alongside Etosha National Park until it reaches point 8. Ilingane coordinates S -18° 30 02.4 and E 015° 39 47.0 where it moved to join point 9. Poli coordinates S -18° 28 48.8 and E 015° 40 35.5. From here boundary moves in a north direction to point 10. Okakango Shooting range coordinates S -18° 25 57.4 and E 015° 43 54.9 where it continues in a straight line to reach point 11., at Oshekedhiya coordinates S -18° 06 03.0 and E 015° 43 33.2 then moves in a straight line in westerly direction to connect with the point of beginning at Oluthalweegolo.
