**DECLARATION OF AN AREA AS A CONSERVANCY:  
UUKOLONKADHI-RUACANA CONSERVANCY**

In terms of paragraph (ii) of subsection (2) of section 24A of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area described in the Schedule to this notice as the Uukolonkadhi-Ruacana Conservancy.

A map and other relevant documents required in terms of section 24A(1)(a) to (d) of that Conservancy lie open for inspection during office hours at the offices of the Directorate: Parks and Wildlife Management of the Ministry of Environment and Tourism: Independence Avenue, Capital Centre, 5th floor, Room No. 15, Windhoek.

**SCHEDULE**

**DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARY:  
UUKOLONKADHI-RUACANA CONSERVANCY**

The point of beginning is at the co-ordinates of point 1 (see table below). From point 1 the boundary line runs in an easterly direction following the course of the Kunene River until the river turns in a northerly direction to point 2. From point 2 the boundary line runs in an easterly direction following the border between Namibia and Angola to point 3. From point 3 the boundary line runs in a southerly direction to point 4. From point 4 the boundary line runs in a south-easterly direction to point 5, from where it runs further in a south-easterly direction to point 6. From point 6 the boundary line runs in a south-westerly direction to point 7, from where it runs further in a south-westerly direction through point 8 to point 9. From point 9 the boundary line runs in a north-westerly direction to point 10, from where it runs further in a north-westerly direction through points 11, 12 and 13 to the point of beginning, point 1.

The townlands of Ruacana are excluded.

The co-ordinates of geographic boundary of the Uukolonkadhi-Ruacana Conservancy are set out in the table.

**DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES:  
SHAMUNGWA CONSERVANCY**

The boundary starts at point A, which is situated 8 km south of Muthinduko village. From this point the boundary follows a southerly direction to point B, which is situated on the road to Shashosho No. 1 and 2. From this point it turns in the westerly direction to point C. From point C it runs in the northern direction to point D, which is situated in the north east of Shamurombwe village. From point D the boundary runs in the easterly direction to the starting point, point A.
