# DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES: AFRICAN WILD DOG CONSERVANCY

The point of beginning is at point 1, situated at the western corner of the boundary of the Conservancy, at the co-ordinates set out below.

From this point the boundary runs in a northerly direction to point 2, wherefrom it runs in an easterly direction to point 3. From point 3 the boundary line runs in a north-easterly direction to point 4. From point 4 the boundary line runs in an easterly direction to point 5. From point 5 the boundary line runs in a north-easterly direction to point 6. From point 6 the boundary line runs in a south-easterly direction to point 7 situated on the Otjozondjou omuramba From point 7 the boundary line runs with the Otjozondjou omuramba in a south-westerly direction to point 8. From point 8 the boundary line runs in a north-easterly direction to point 9. From point 9 the boundary line runs in a south-westerly to point 10. From point 10 the boundary line runs in a southerly direction to point 11. From point 11 the boundary line runs in a north-westerly direction to point 12. From point 12 the boundary line runs in a north-westerly direction to point 13 wherefrom the boundary line runs in a westerly direction to the point of beginning.

## DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES: !GAWACHAB CONSERVANCY

The point of beginning is at point 1, situated at the northern corner of the boundary of the Conservancy, bordering on the southern corner of the farm Gipslaagte, at the co-ordinates set out below.

From this point the boundary line runs in a south-easterly direction along the border of the Naute Game Park to point 2, wherefrom the boundary line continues to run along the border of the Naute Game Park in a south-westerly direction to point 3. From point 3 the boundary line runs in a south-easterly direction to point 4. From point 4 the boundary line continues to run in a south-easterly direction along the border of the Naute Game Park to point 5. From point 5 the boundary line runs in a north-westerly direction along the border of the farm Chamates to point 6, wherefrom the boundary line continues to run along the border of the farm Chamates in a north-westerly direction to point 7. From point 7 the boundary line runs in a north-easterly direction along the border of the farm Sunnyside to the point of beginning.
