DECLARATION OF AN AREA AS A CONSERVANCY: KING NEHALE CONSERVANCY

In terms of paragraph (ii) of subsection (2) of section 24A of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area described in the Schedule to this notice as the King Nehale Conservancy.

A map and other relevant documents required in terms of section 24A(1)(a) to (d) of that conservancy lie open for inspection during office hours at the offices of the Directorate: Parks and Wildlife Management of the Ministry of Environment and Tourism: Independence Avenue, Capital Centre, 5th Floor, Room No. 15, Windhoek.

SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES: KING NEHALE CONSERVANCY

The area is an open system with boundaries on three triangle sides made up of ten points. The co-ordinates start at point number 1 (see table below) at Omuthiya and continue along the power line from Omuthiya to Okangololosa to point numbers 2, 3, 4 and 5. From point 5 the line continues along point 6 and 7 and then turns right to point 8 where it joins a natural small stream on the west and continues to point 9 at Etosha National Park. From point 9 the line runs along the fence of Etosha National Park to point 10 on the east and joins the Tsumeb - Ondangwa main road whereupon it rejoins point number 1 to complete the circle.
