### DECLARATION OF AN AREA AS A CONSERVANCY

Under section 24A(2)(ii) of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area, of which the geographic boundaries are set out in the Schedule, as the Mashi Conservancy.

A map of the said conservancy shall lie open for inspection during office hours at the offices of the Directorate: Parks and Wildlife Management, Independence Avenue, Capital Centre, 5th Floor, Room No. 15.

## DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES OF THE MASHI CONSERVANCY SITUATED IN THE CAPRIVI REGION

The point of beginning is at the co-ordinates of point 1 (see table below), which is on the Kwando River. From the point of beginning the boundary runs in a south-easterly direction to point 2, before turning to the north-east through points 3, 4 and 5. From point 5 the boundary moves in a south-easterly direction to point 6 and then in a southerly direction through points 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. Point 11 is situated on the proclaimed northern boundary of Mudumu National Park. From point 11 the line follows the proclaimed Mudumu National Park boundary in a south-westerly direction to point 12 and then westwards to point 13 which is on the Kwando River. From point 13 the boundary follows the Kwando River in a northerly direction until the point of beginning (point 1).
