DECLARATION OF AN AREA AS A CONSERVANCY: !KHOB !NAUB (KALK PLATEAU) CONSERVANCY

In terms of section 24A(2)(ii) of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area, of which the geographic boundaries are set out in the Schedule, as the !Khob !Naub (Kalk Plateau) Conservancy situated in the Karas Region.

A map of that conservancy will lie open for inspection at the offices of the Directorate: Parks and Wildlife Management in the Ministry of Environment and Tourism, Capital Centre, Independence Avenue, Windhoek.

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY OF THE !KHOB !NAUB (KALK PLATEAU) CONSERVANCY SITUATED IN THE KARAS REGION

The point of beginning is at the co-ordinates of point 1. From this point the boundary moves in a south-eastern direction through point 2, 3 and 4 before moving south-westerly to point 5. From point 5 the boundary moves southwards through point 6, 7, 8 and 9. From point 9 the boundary follows the northern boundaries of the farms Blau-Ost 143 and Blaukehl-Nord 141 and then moves southwards along the eastern boundaries of the farms Blaukehl-Nord 41 and Blaukehl-SUD 142. The boundary then moves in a northwestern direction along the southern boundary of the farm Blaukehl-Sud 142 before turning southwards along the eastern boundary of the farm Bloemhof 311 and then northwesterly along the southern boundary of Bloemhof 311. From this last point the boundary moves southwards along the eastern boundary of the farm Itzawisis 9 and then in a south-western direction along the southern boundary of the farm Itzawisis 9 until it meets the railway line. The boundary then follows the railway line in a northern direction until it meets the southern boundary of the farm Dickdorn 13. From this point the boundary follows the southern boundary of Dickdorn 13 westwards for a short distance before turning northwards along the western boundary of Dickdorn 13 and then eastwards along the northern boundaries of farms Dickdorn 13 and Mukorob 14. From this point the boundary runs southwards along the eastern boundary of Mukorob 14 and then in a south-eastern direction along the common boundaries separating state land and the farms Daberas Pforte 15 and Zaries 20 and then to the point of beginning.

The Townlands of Tses are excluded.

DECLARATION OF AN AREA AS A CONSERVANCY: N#A-JAQNA CONSERVANCY

In terms of section 24A(2)(ii) of the Nature Conservation Ordinance, 1975 (Ordinance No. 4 of 1975), I declare the area, of which the geographic boundaries are set out in the Schedule, as the N#a-Jaqna Conservancy situated in the Otjozondjupa Region.

A map of that conservancy will lie open for inspection at the offices of the Directorate: Parks and Wildlife Management in the Ministry of Environment and Tourism, Capital Centre, Independence Avenue, Windhoek.

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARY OF THE N#A-JAQNA CONSERVANCY SITUATED IN THE OTJOZONDJUPA REGION

The point of beginning is at point 1, which is situated in the south-eastern corner of the conservancy. From the point of beginning the boundary follows the veterinary fence in a western direction up to point 2, when it turns north-westerly along the veterinary fence to point 3 and then in a northern direction still following the veterinary fence to point 4. From this point the boundary turns eastwards to point 5 and then in a south-western direction up to point 6, whereupon it follows a road in a north-eastern direction to point 7. From here the boundary moves in a south-western direction to point 8 before turning southwards to point 9, which is situated on the main Tsumkwe-Grootfontein road. The boundary follows this road in a western direction through point 10 to point 11, before turning southwards to point 12 and then in a south-western direction to point 13. From this point the boundary follows a road in a southern direction up to the point of beginning.
