

considered a reflection of conservancy management. They indicate the current status of wildlife in the conservancy in relation to a theoretical optimal situation.



Human wildlife conflict trend




Most troublesome problem animals 2020-2022

the chart shows the number of incidents per species for the last 3 years; the darkest bar (on the right) indicates the current year for each species




Type of damage by problem animals 2020-2022

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





Current wildlife numbers and status






Annual Game Count Charts show the number of animals seen each year per 100 km of transect Status flags reflect the general sightings trend over the last 5 years











